B. A SUMMER'S READING/ Bernard Malamud

הנבחנים נדרשו לענות על שאלות 10-6

6. (iv) She helps him when she thinks he is reading.
7. (iii) asks different questions.
8. (i) They don't know that George lied.
9. From George's answer, we learn that he is passive. George does nothing to get a job, although he wants to achieve more in his life. In addition, he stays in his room most of the day and doesn't read the books. We also learn that George wants people's respect. He lies to Mr.Cattazara about the reading because he wants Mr.Cattanzara to appreciate him. When George feels that the neighbors don't respect him, he doesn't like them and he stays in his room.

10. Thinking skill I chose: Inferring/Uncovering Motives

I assume that Mr.Cattanzara spread the rumor that George finished reading the books for two reasons; He knew that George wanted people to respect him. By telling the neighbors that George read the books, Mr.Cattanzara made George feel that the neighbors respect him. Mr.Cattanzara hoped that George would start reading in order to maintain this good feeling. In addition, I think that Mr.Cattanzara's goal was to deliver George a message that he had another opportunity to change his life. It was important for Mr.Cattanzara that George would read ; he told him to speak with him about the books, his eyes were sad when he saw George and he told him not to do his mistakes.

15. Thinking skill I chose: Inferring/Uncovering Motives/Comparing and Contrasting
