PART I (46 points)

A. SUMMER'S READING / Bernard Melamud

הנבחנים נדרשו לענות על שאלות 1-5

- 1. (iv) stays at home all day
- 2. (ii) reads newspapers after work
- 3. (iii) finished reading many books
- 4. Sophie is George's older sister. Her character is presented as an opposite one to George's character. George is passive in his life, doesn't work, and doesn't do anything to achieve his goals to read books and get an education. In contrast to George, Sophie is presented as a hard-working girl. She is active, she works long hours in a cafeteria and she reads whatever falls into her hands. Sophie is also presented as a character who tries to push George to change his life. She gives George money when she thinks he reads books to encourage him, and asks him about his reading. When George stays in his room for a week, she worries about him and tries to convince him to go out.
- 5. Thinking skill I chose: Explaining cause and effect/Inferring.

When George meets Mr. Cattanzara for the second time, he understands that Mr. Cattanzara knows that he lies about his reading. Mr. Cattanzara treats George like a child by offering him money to buy lemon ice. He asks him about the books, and George can't give him a good answer to that. George feels ashamed. He is also afraid that Mr. Cattanzara and the neighbors will not respect him anymore. I assume that these are the reasons why he



feels he is "crumbling apart".
