A. A SUMMER'S READING/ Bernard Malamud

הנבחנים נדרשו לענות על שאלות 1-5

- 2. (iv) doesn't talk to George about reading
- 3. (ii) don't spend time with George
- 4. Sophie is a hard working young woman. She works every day in a cafeteria. When Sophie thinks that George reads books, she gives him an allowance to encourage him. After the second meeting with Mr.Cattanzara, George refuses to come out of his room. Sophie figures out that he probably doesn't read. It makes her angry. Therefore, Sophie tells George that she doesn't need to work so hard for him, if he does nothing to change his life.
- 5. When George comes out of his room, he finds out that Mr. Cattanzara didn't tell the neighbors that he lied. That causes him to go to the library and start reading. I assume George does it for two reasons: first, he wants the neighbors to keep respecting him. George feels good when he is respected by his neighbors.

 Second, George wants to show Mr. Cattanzara that he still deserves his help and trust. Mr. Cattanzara tried hard to make George read he asked him about his reading plans, and spread a rumor that George reads. George feels that Mr.Cattanzara gives him another opportunity to prove himself, and he doesn't want to disappoint him.
